Project Highlights

- Successful launch of two Innovative WIL opportunities, promoting participation in the NET ZERO boot camp
- Received survey responses from 363 businesses and non-profits in Calgary; final survey report provided by Stone Olafson
- Development of the Innovative WIL Experiential Learning Record
- Development of the WIL decision tree to aid in the process of WIL type selection
- 5 portal issues have been solved in the month of July
- The TalentED YYC website had 401 unique visitors in the month of July
- Our first TalentED YYC e-newsletter was distributed to 38 subscribers
